DENDROBIUMS. W = Warm; I = Intermediate; W-I = Warm to Intermediate. I or W-I will tolerate cool periods if watered less.
Dendrobium types : (S) = Spatulata (antelope); (P) = Phalaenanthe; (F) = Formosae (Nigrohirsute); (L) = Latouria (New Guinea type); and (N) = Nobile.

Our nobile hybrids bloom under warm to intermediate conditions & do not require a starving or chilling period & do best grown bright. Latourias (New Guinea types) do well under wide range of conditions, wet, shady, cool, warm, bright. Evergreen & disease resistant. Blooms for months.
